Snack is available to all students enrolled in afterschool activities. Many programs end between **4:15** and **4:30 p.m.**, though some off-site programs might not return to school until **5 p.m.** Transportation to and from all off-site programs will be provided. After the scheduled activities finish at Hunt, join the **Sara Holbrook Teen Center** fun at the **Miller Center** until **5:30 p.m.**

- ◆ Be committed to the activities you sign-up for and attend regularly. It is important to be a contributing part of your afterschool activities.
- ◆ Snack and Supper is served everyday—free of charge! Supper is served in the Cafeteria at **3 p.m. (2:15 p.m. Wednesdays)** and Snack is taken to the individual afterschool activities.
- ◆ Transportation will be provided to and from all off-site activities.
- ◆ The **Sara Holbrook Teen Center**, at the **Miller Community Center** next to **HMS**, is open **Monday through Friday** from **3-5:30 p.m.** and on **Wednesday** from **2-5:30 p.m.**

- ◆ **Sign in and sign out!**
- ◆ Morning Homework Help begins at **7 a.m.** Students must be in the Library by **7:30 a.m.** if they wish to attend.
- ◆ You must bring your assignment with you.
- ◆ Read a book or remain quiet after you have finished working.
- ◆ Move to a quieter area if you need it.
- ◆ Only use computers for homework.
- ◆ Let someone know if you need to go to your locker or the bathroom.

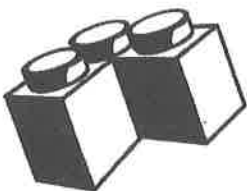
BE ABOVE
