## Session 1: September 16 to October 24

### **3-D ORIGAMI**

Modular origami or unit origami is a paper folding technique which uses two or more sheets of paper to create a larger and more complex structure than would be possible using single-piece origami technique. Each individual sheet of paper is folded into a module, or unit, and then modules are assembled into an integrated flat shape that holds the model together. These insertions create tension or friction or three dimensional structure by inserting flaps into pockets created by the folding process. We will make toys and other models. **Join Ms. Rossell in her classroom. Tuesday, 3:15-4:30pm.**

- ◆ Let someone know if you need to go to your locker or the bathroom.
