On Thursday, Advisory teachers read a message from me to students about this issue, the problems with it and consequences. I will be addressing students about this during the Monday virtual assembly. I am also working with our Office of Equity to address students toward the end of next week.

My ask is that you join us in the efforts. Please talk to your children about why it is important to keep all toy guns and toy weapons at home. The reality is that bringing a toy gun to school results in suspension. It may not feel like a big deal, but there is no gray area here and the consequences of this are serious, because the impact on the school community is serious.

Hello 8th grade parents/guardians!

Here is some information about how your 8th grader will register for classes for BHS.

On 1/25 there was a parent information meeting at BHS.

On 1/27 BHS counselors met with Hunt 8th graders. They gave general information to kids about what to expect at BHS, what courses are required and how to choose electives.

Our Hunt staff will be making course recommendations in power school for your child. Science, Math, EL and Special Education teachers will be making the recommendations. Many classes are required and there is not a lot of room for electives, but there are some!

The week of 2/6, I will be meeting with students during math classes to get them registered for their high school classes. BHS will be sending parents information about how to see the classes your child has registered for. Your child can also show you how they logged in!

BHS will work on scheduling through the spring, and plans to have a meeting in May to welcome you to BHS, and get you more information about your child's final schedule.

Health and Wellness Survey


